

Donor Bill of Rights

Supporters of The Magdalen House have the right to

- I. Carefully stored personal information, and the confidence that personal information will never be lent or sold.
- II. Know how the funds that they donate are being used.
- III. Know the outcomes of the programs that they support.
- IV. Know that The Magdalen House abides by all federal, state, and local laws.
- V. A timely and courteous response to inquiries about finances and programs.
- VI. Visit the offices and program sites of The Magdalen House and talk personally with staff.
- VII. Obtain a copy of The Magdalen House's most recent IRS Form 990 and Annual Report.
- VIII. Know that all appeals for funds are truthful and accurate.
- IX. Give cheerfully without being pressured.
- X. Be informed of the identity of those serving on The Magdalen House's governing board and expect prudent judgement in their stewardship responsibilities.
- XI. Expect respect and confidentiality with regard to their donation as provided by the law.
- XII. Receive appropriate acknowledgement and recognition.
